

Cookie Policy

We use web technologies, including cookies and similar tracking technologies, on our website to collect and process personal data for the purposes of content personalization and the analysis of traffic across our website, applications, and the Internet.

Before using our website, you must provide your consent to the use of certain categories of cookies. You may consent to the use of specific categories of cookies. You have the option to accept all cookies, reject optional cookies, or customize your cookie preferences individually.

Your consent may be withdrawn or modified at any time through the Cookie Settings Panel available on our website.

If you do not consent to the use of any of the cookie categories listed therein, we will still be required to use strictly necessary (functional) cookies, as these are essential to ensure the proper operation of the website.

The legal basis for the use of strictly necessary cookies is the Controller's legitimate interest in ensuring the proper functioning and security of the website, as well as the exemption provided under applicable electronic communications legislation for technically necessary cookies.

The legal basis for the use of analytics, advertising, and other optional cookies is the user's consent pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

The retention period for individual cookies depends on their type and processing purpose. Detailed information regarding retention periods is provided in the Cookie Table included in this Policy.

You have the following rights under the GDPR:

- a) the right of access to personal data;
- b) the right to rectification of personal data;
- c) the right to erasure of personal data;
- d) the right to restriction of processing;
- e) the right to object to processing;
- f) the right to withdraw consent at any time;

g) the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority, namely the **Integritetsskyddsmyndigheten (IMY)**.

As the Controller, we use a Consent Management Platform (CMP) that enables you to:

- a) provide consent;
- b) refuse consent;
- c) modify consent settings;
- d) withdraw consent at any time.

Records relating to the consents provided may be retained for the purpose of demonstrating compliance with applicable legal requirements.

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device by websites that you visit. They are widely used to make websites function efficiently, enhance website performance, and provide information to website owners. The use of cookies is now standard practice for most websites.

What Types of Cookies Do We Use?

Strictly Necessary (Functional) Cookies

These cookies are essential for the proper operation of our website and systems and for providing core functionalities such as security, user authentication, and the storage of privacy preferences. They enable you to navigate our website and use its features.

Preference Cookies

These cookies allow the website to remember choices you make, such as your preferred language or geographic region.

Analytics Cookies

These cookies enable us to monitor website traffic and communications, evaluate how users interact with the website, and collect and analyze data in order to improve our services and customer support processes.

Advertising Cookies

We may use advertising technologies that display advertisements on third-party websites. These cookies help ensure that advertising content is relevant to your interests and preferences and enable us to measure the effectiveness of advertising campaigns.

Third-Party Cookies

These cookies activate specific applications, features, and functionalities provided by third parties, including business and social networking services, mapping services, and search functionalities.

Depending on the duration for which cookies are stored on your device, cookies may also be categorized as follows:

Session Cookies

These cookies remain on your device only for the duration of your visit to our website.

Persistent Cookies

These cookies remain on your device until their specified expiration date or until they are manually deleted.
